In addition to ballroom dancing, your "Dancing with the Wines" package includes wine and spirits sampling, light finger

Smoking is permitted in our outdoor courtyard.

Cocktail of the Month



Pisco Sour

You will fall in love with Pisco Sours. This refreshing cocktail is the most popular drink served in South America. Try a Pisco Sour next time you're in the mood for a Margarita.

Note: the raw egg white can be substituted with pasteurized egg whites or foaming sugar.

Recipe

- 1.5 oz Don Quixote Pisco
- 0.75 oz lime juice
- 1.0 oz simple syrup
- 1 egg white
- 3 dashes Don Quixote orange bitters

Pour the Don Quixote Pisco, lime juice, simple syrup and egg white into a shaker filled with ice. Shake well to the rhythm of a Latin Samba.

Strain into a chilled cocktail glass. Dash in bitters to taste.

Careful, this cocktail is so smooth and refreshing you may drink too much.

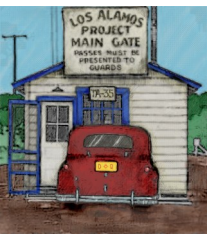
This event is planned from noon to 3pm on the second Saturday of each month.

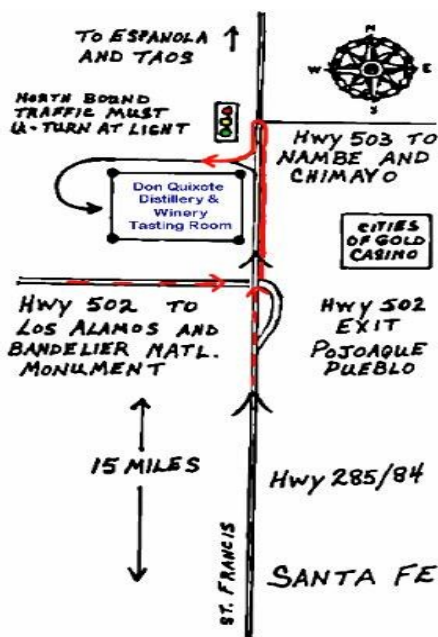
New Life for an Old Landmark
